Housekeeping

Feathered Pipe is looking for a Housekeeper to join our team. Your responsibilities include cleaning, changing beds, helping guests as needed, and other duties as assigned. Many different situations arise at a guest ranch with lodging accommodations and facilities spread across a spacious Ranch, so we appreciate applicants with diverse skills who are willing to jump in when needed and respond to requests and feedback. You must be able to lift at least 25 pounds and have a keen eye for neatness and cleanliness.

Respect for health, nature and wildlife is our priority, so we use natural cleaning products and avoid using chemicals/poisons, whenever possible and effective.

Core Responsibilities

- Cleaning all facilities including but not limited to: common areas, rooms, indoor and outdoor accommodations (including yurts, tents, and tipis), bathhouse, and kitchen (deep clean).
- Cleaning duties include sweeping, mopping, vacuuming, dusting, collecting and disposing of trash, changing/making beds, window washing, toilet/bathroom cleaning, cleaning up spills, etc.
- Doing towel and linen laundry on-site: washing, drying and folding
- Bringing and collecting laundry that is done off-site

- Stocking and organizing linen closets
- Assessing the accommodation and notifying manager if any repairs need to be done.
- Responding to guests needs and assisting guests when necessary.
- Helping guests to and from their accommodations when they arrive and depart (porter).
- Helping with set up and take down of the Ranch facilities.
- Participating in meetings.
- Other duties as assigned.

Requirements

- Cleaning experience.
- Self-motivated and ability to see and accomplish tasks that need to be done.
- Willingness to work as part of a team
- Openness to feedback and ability to respond to that feedback.
- Able to lift at least 25 pounds
- Able to interact positively with guests and respond to their requests
- Adaptability and flexibility
- Be willing to follow COVID-19 protocols including but not limited to **mask wearing**. Protocols are subject to change.
